- The prefix "Assistant" before a position within the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., denotes "College Brother" position.
- There are various Assistant District Directors that represent each of their respective Districts within each Region.
- The Assistant District Director is the *Highest Position* a
 College Brother can hold in his respective **District**.









- Assist the District Director in dealing with College Chapter affairs in their respective districts.
- Perform such other duties as may be assigned to them by the District Director or by the Regional Vice President of their Region.
- > Represent all chapters on the District Board of Directors.









- Recommend Brothers to district & regional standing and special committees.
- Join with the District Director in making recommendations to the District Conference on how funds are to be used.
- Assist in preparations for conferences in their respective districts.







- Develop the "College Brother's Caucus" as a means of promoting togetherness and brotherly accord.
- Work with Area Directors and Assistant Area Directors in facilitating those specific competitive programs mandated for College Chapters by the General Organization.
- Review with District Director annually the Directory and Chapter Report and give feedback to chapters.







- Encourage graduating seniors to affiliate with an alumni chapter upon graduation.
- Plan the District "College Brothers Summit".
- Work alongside the Regional Assistant Vice President in planning the College Brothers Empowerment.
- Work with College Chapters throughout the District on programming, leadership development, and academic success.







Things to Consider

Time Commitment (School, Alpha, Community & Etc.) Leadership Experiences (Campus, Community, Fraternal & Etc.) Monetary Allocations (Travel, Campaign Material & Etc.) Understand the Fraternity Structure (Districts, Regions & General Level)

Platform Development

Vision (What would you and Brothers want to see?)

Create a Slogan (Something that's unique)

Platform Pillars (Look at areas within the Fraternity that can be improved, but be realistic)

Find Mentor

Identify a Brother who can guide you through the Campaign Process





Step 2: Building A Campaign Team

Identify Campaign Manager

Oversees the Campaign Process

Direct Contact for Brothers on Campaign Team

Document All Records (Donations, Endorsements & Expenditures Etc.)

Target Alumni & Collegiate Brothers

Identify Alumni & Collegiate Brothers to Serve on Team

Have Representation among Areas

Look into Brothers who are Social & Influencers

Identify Campaign Assignments & Duties



Seek Endorsements

Target the following: Chapters & Presidents

Area, District, Regional & General Leadership

Create a method to showcase support

Identify District Delegate Strength

Create a Registry of all Chapters in your District









Know your Platform & How the Fraternity Operates

Understand the Hierarchy of the Fraternity and How it functions Always know your platform & How your vision can support the Fraternity Be prepared for the tough questions

Prepare Speeches for District Conference

Write your Nomination Acceptance Speech in advance Have your support pitch to each area ready before Area Caucuses Be prepared for a Campaign Debate

Identify Nominators for Election

Identify a College & Alumni Brother to Nominate you (Not from the same area)







Pros vs. Cons of ADD Role



Pros

- Personal & Career Development
- Accommodated Travel Opportunities
- Valuable Networking
- Tangible leadership skills that translate to other leadership roles
 - Attend Alpha Leadership Academy

Cons

- Time Commitment
- Missing Classes & Special Events
- Reduced involvement on Chapter Level
- Unscheduled Fraternal Meetings
- 1 Year Tenure
- Delayed reimbursements or advances



Benefits of ADD Role




- Attend District Conferences & Regional/General Conventions
